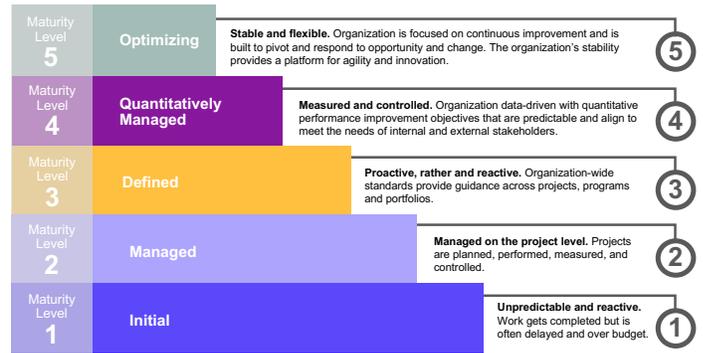

Program Maturity Review

The Program Maturity Review provides a standardized approach to measuring your program maturity on a quarterly basis. You start by completing a baseline assessment designed to identify gaps or potential deficiencies in your TPRM program. The Prevalent Professional Services team then reviews your responses, prioritizes potential program risks, and works with you to define realistic objectives.

You also receive a maturity score, which serves as a benchmark for demonstrating progression as you evolve your TPRM program. All issues are recorded in a risk register in the Prevalent TPRM Platform, which also connects you to remediation capabilities including status tracking, task management, and discussion threads.

Platform Functionality Review

The Platform Functionality Review provides visibility into where you can gain additional efficiency and value from the Prevalent TPRM Platform. By performing this exercise on a quarterly basis, you ensure that your processes incorporate the latest Prevalent functionality and best practices.

The service begins with an in-platform assessment to identify potential functionality or consideration gaps. After you complete the initial assessment, the Prevalent Professional Services team provides a summary report detailing functionality gaps and potential areas for optimization.

The team then conducts a walkthrough session to provide context behind identified gaps and to validate potential enhancements that would provide additional value. Finally, validated functionality gaps are imported into the platform risk register to plan and scope configuration and/or implementation.

Achievable Milestone Review

The annual Achievable Milestone Review validates that program goals are achievable based on current resources and processes. The Prevalent Professional Services team first conducts a workshop with your team to understand your assessment volume and timeframe requirements.

We then estimate your current program capacity and measure it against your goals and success criteria. If there is a gap between your capacity and goals, then we identify where additional resources, process improvements, or goal realignment may be required.

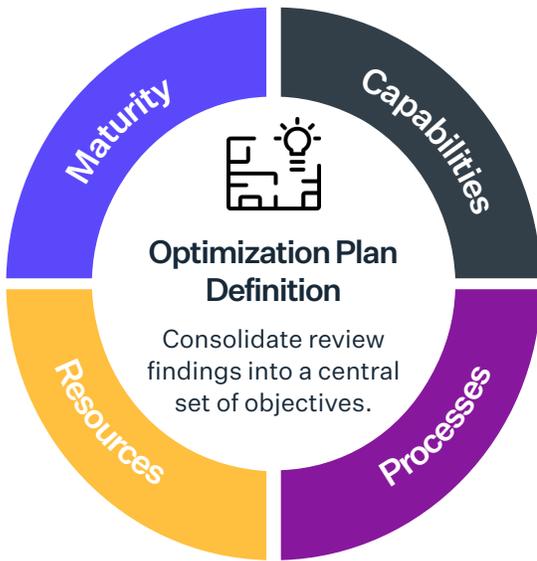
